TARDINESS POLICY

At South Texas ISD World Scholars, being on time is one of our non-negotiables. Student who are late to class will face the following penalties:

Occurrence	Consequence
Tardy to AM periods	1 day of lunch detention, per occurrence, to be served on the day of the occurrence (for students who are tardy to BOTH 1 st and 2 nd period, 2 days of lunch detention will be assigned).
Tardy to PM periods	1 day of lunch detention, per occurrence, to be served the following school day (for students who are tardy to BOTH 3 rd and 4 th period, 2 days of lunch detention will be assigned).
Skipping lunch detention	Students who skip lunch detention will be assigned 2 days of lunch detention
Skipping lunch detention 3 times or more	Student and parent will conference with the assistant principal and student may be placed in ISS (in-school suspension)

CELLULAR PHONE /ELECTRONIC DEVICE POLICY

At South Texas ISD World Scholars, **students are required to turn in their cellular phones to the teacher at the start of every class and are responsible for picking them up at the end of class.** This will ensure that students are engaged in their lessons and limit distractions.

**Although South Texas ISD encourages students to bring their own technology to school under the "Bring Your Own Device" policy, South Texas ISD is not responsible for lost or damaged devices that students choose to bring with them.*

OUTSIDE FOOD POLICY

Our goal at South Texas ISD World Scholars is to provide the safest environment for all of our students. To this end, the delivery of outside food from vendors and/or food delivery services is- prohibited.

South Texas ISD World Scholars E-Cigarette Free Policy

Policy

This e-cigarette policy prohibits the use of electronic nicotine delivery systems (also known as, but not limited to, e-cigarettes, e-cigars, e-hookahs, e-pipes, vapes, juul) anywhere that tobacco smoking is prohibited regardless of the substance being delivered by the device.

No vaping is permitted within the facilities of South Texas ISD World Scholars at any time. This includes, but is not limited to, common work areas, auditoriums, classrooms, conference and meeting rooms, private offices, hallways, cafeterias, gymnasiums, employee lounges, restrooms, vehicles parked on campus property and/or within 300 feet of campus property, and all school sponsored events on and off campus.

This policy is effective immediately.

Definition:

Vaping refers to the use of electronic nicotine delivery systems or electronic smoking devices.

Disciplinary Action

Any student who is found to be in possession of an e-cigarette device, and/or paraphernalia, will be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the South Texas ISD Student Code of Conduct and the Texas Association of School Boards (TASB) Chapter 37 Discipline Chart.

Disciplinary actions may include, but are not limited to, on, and/or off, campus suspension, placement in the District Alternative Education Program (DAEP), expulsion, and/or reporting to local authorities.

Supplemental Dress Code

1. Caps/Hats are not to be worn inside South Texas ISD World Scholars
2. Skirts and shorts must fall no shorter than 2 inches above the knee

Student Parking

All students wishing to park at South Texas ISD World Scholars must obtain a parking permit from the front office. In order to obtain a parking permit, students must present a valid Texas Driver's License and proof of insurance.

Vehicles that are parked at World Scholars without a valid parking permit may be towed.
